Ordinance to Amend the Building Code Ordinance 9-7-16A

The Saratoga Town Board, County of Wood, do hereby ordain and amend the Building Code Ordinance as follow:

The Addition of Section:


3. Camping Units
 - A. Authority. These regulations are adopted under the authority granted by s 101.63, Wisconsin Statutes.
 - B. Purpose. The Purposed of this ordinance is to maintain required local uniformity with the administrative and technical requirements of new camping units as defined in Wis. Admin. Code Chapter SPS 327.
 - C. Scope. The provisions of this code apply to all comping units for which construction commenced on or after February 6, 2017.
 - D. Building Code Ordinance 9-7-16A. The Town of Saratoga Building code shall incorporate by reference of the Camping Unit Code, SPS 327 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and all amendments thereto, and shall apply to all camping units within the scope of this ordinance.
 - E. Building Inspector. The Building Inspector enforcing this code shall possess the certifications of UDC Construction Inspection, UDC Electrical, UDC HVAC, and UDC Plumbing.
 - F. Building Permit Required. No person shall build any Camping Unit without first obtaining a permit as required by SPS 327.09(1).



This amendment to the Building Code shall be effective upon passage upon the Town Board of the Town of Saratoga and upon publication provided by law


